you have the message of e-/ternal life.

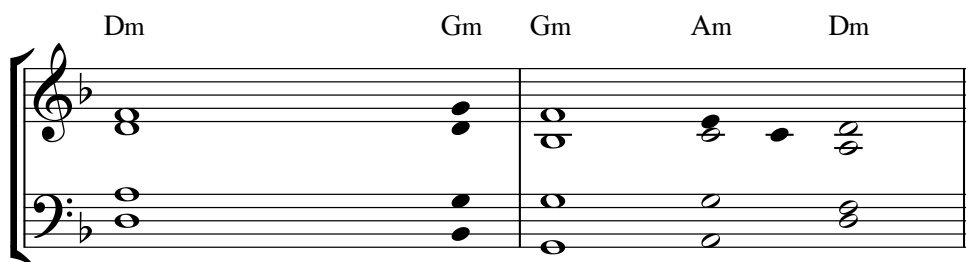

Consecrate us / in the truth.

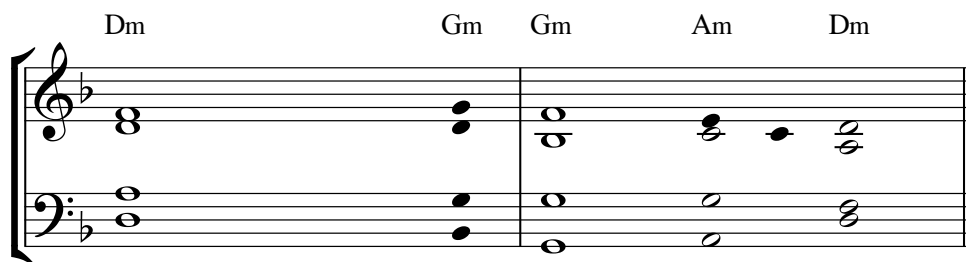
24th Sunday in Ordinary Time A - 17th September
